Indie School – Needs Based Funding Approach

The Albury Wodonga Community College Limited 'Indie' School takes the following approach to the Australian Government's (Department of Education) 'needs-based funding arrangements' in accordance with Section 78(5) of the *Australian Education Act 2013*.

- Base level funding for each student at the Albury Wodonga Community College 'Indie' School is by:
 - **By passing on the Australian Government's base funding directly to our school.**
- Loadings for students with a disability, Aboriginal Torres Strait Islander (ATSI) students, students with socio-educational disadvantage, students with low English proficiency at the Albury Wodonga Community College 'Indie' School is by:
 - **By passing on the Australian Government's 'loadings' directly to our school.**
- Reserving an amount of Australian Government recurrent funding for administrative functions at the Albury Wodonga Community College 'Indie' School is by:
 - **Setting aside a budgeted 8.5% of the base funding and loadings (combined) expected to be received annually.**
 - **The Albury Wodonga Community College Limited has as history shows, underwritten our Indie School from other Albury Wodonga Community College Limited funding sources when this amount has been insufficient to the needs of the School.**
- The Albury Wodonga Community College 'Indie' School:
 - **only distributes recurrent funding received to the purposes of our school delivery.**
